Agricultural Safety and Health

SaferFarn – Complete resource to conduct an objective farm hazard inspection.

Managing Agricultural Emergencies – Training program for responding safely and effectively to agricultural emergencies. Approved by Homeland Security.

Manure Storage and Handling Safety – Ventilation standard and educational material for manure pit safety. Videos, mobile demo, factsheets, and online software development for engineers.

Demonstrations and Simulations- Several life size and tabletop interactive models for educational meetings that can be scheduled for use in classroom or community.

eXtension – International Ag Safety and Health Community of Practice through eXtension of over 95 ag safety and health experts to develop and review material on the site.

NSTMOP – National Safe Tractor and Machinery Operation Program is curriculum for 14 & 15 year olds; inexperienced operators; and new/ beginning farmers. Task sheets in English and Spanish and certificate program for youth employed on farms.

AgSafety4U – Online ag safety and health certificate course that consists of 7 units, (lessons & required tests).

ROPS Retrofit – Funds provided to farmers to help install ROPS on their tractors. Currently, there is a waiting list because there are more requests than available funds at this time.

Safety in Agriculture for Youth (SAY) - Maintain and expand a national clearinghouse for curriculum and resources aligned with AFNR Career Cluster Standards.

Grain Bin Anchor Point Project – Grant through the Northeast Center to research grain bin anchor points.

Safety and Health Management Planning for General Farm and Ranch Operations – Provides educational and management resources for new and beginning farmers.

Organizing and Conducting A Safe Tractor Driving Workshop – Manual that provides detailed instructions for employers on organizing and conducting a safe tractor training workshop.

Safety and Health in On-Farm Biomass Production – Exploring safety and health aspects of on-farm biomass production.

AgrAbility for Pennsylvanians – Provides services to farmers that have difficulties completing farm tasks because of a long-term health condition (e.g., arthritis) or injury.
