We will **contact registry members** when a study that matches their interest is looking to work with farmers.

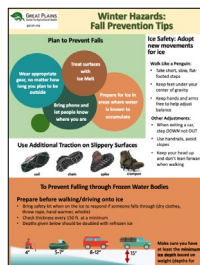
Studies have included:

- Noise exposures
- Hearing protection effectiveness
- Tractor/machinery vibration studies and how it relates to back pain
- “Farm Safety Checklist”

- Regional health and safety needs assessments
- Safety materials designed to share with farmers





Farmer/Rancher Registry



How it works:

- Read the consent to decide whether or not to join the registry
- You can enter data online or on paper to be entered into **secure** database by registry staff
- You'll receive a **unique** ID number that only you and database managers will know
- Researchers looking for volunteers will submit detailed info to our registry staff to verify that their research is
 - relevant to our mission
 - IRB-approved
 - appropriate for our region's farmers
- If the study is approved, **registry staff will contact you**, using your preferred method, with information about the research study.
- **You make the choice to participate or not**, and you contact the investigator if you wish to participate.
