

Pruning Dwarf Fruit and Nut Trees

Can youth do this job safely?

Youth must be able to do/have all of the following to perform this job safely:

- · Avoid loose clothing, clothes with strings, tie up long hair
- Climb safely, using proper climbing technique
- · Mature enough to consistently do what is expected
- · Think through actions and consequences before acting
- Attention span long enough to complete work
- Physical stamina to perform job for 50 minutes
- Safely demonstrate job 4-5 times
- · Maintain two-way communication link
- · Wash hands when job is finished



Adult Responsibilities

- · Comply with the working outdoors guideline
- · Provide safe transport to the work area
- · Ensure re-entry standards are followed
- Confirm youth is free of insect allergies or has remedy available
- Ensure work area is free from as many hazards as possible
- Educate youth on avoiding/addressing remaining hazards
- · Ensure cutting tools are properly sized for youth
- Provide appropriate training on the safe use of cutting tools
- Demonstrate how to safely prune fruit and nut trees

Supervision

If climbing a ladder:

12-13 yrs Constant supervision

14-15 yrs Constant supervision progressing to

intermittent

16+ yrs Intermittent supervision progressing to

periodic


